Dennis R. Robertson is currently Associate Director of Philanthropy for Heifer International in Little Rock, Arkansas.

Heifer International is a nonprofit humanitarian organization that works to end hunger and poverty and care for the Earth. Since 1944, Heifer has provided livestock and training in their care to over 10.5 million families in more than 125 countries.

Dennis joined the organization in 2008 after serving as President/CEO of Pinnacle Business Solutions, Inc. Pinnacle served as a government contractor with the Department of Health and Human Services where it processed and paid Medicare claims to beneficiaries in 6 states. Pinnacle employed over 1700 employees. Prior to Pinnacle, Robertson served as Executive Vice President for the Arkansas Farm Bureau Federation, its affiliated companies and the Arkansas Mutual Insurance Company. The Farm Bureau served over 240,000 families in Arkansas. Dennis was also Vice President for Governmental Affairs with the Arkansas Electric Cooperatives and served as Chief of Staff and Agricultural Assistant to U.S. Senator David Pryor in Washington, D.C.
